## **Opening:**

Write a new opening prayer that covers the basics of what a lodge or other masonic body needs before you get to work. Try to balance all of the needs of the Body with Brevity.

will skillfully tend to your servants today. May all our efforts be pleasing in your sight. In your
name we pray. Amen."

### **Closing:**

Write a new closing prayer that covers the basics of what a lodge or other masonic body needs before you leave the lodge room. Try to balance all of the needs of the Body with brevity.

• "Almighty Father, we offer our humble thanks for the opportunity to serve you and the opportunity to serve our neighbors in their time of difficulty. May our modest donation aid in their recovery so that they may continue serving you and doing good works in your name. Amen."

#### Sick and distressed:

Write a prayer for sick and distressed that covers the needs of what a lodge or other masonic body might hear during a call for news of sick and distressed. Try to balance all of the needs of the Body with focus and privacy.

• "Almighty Father, we pray for those who are suffering, in sickness, in poor health, and are stricken by traumatic events. May your children who are in need find comfort in your presence. In your Holy name we pray. Amen."

#### **Option:**

Write a prayer for a situation that you think you might see in your lodge or in another masonic body. The prayer should enable members present to know what to pray for after they depart from the building. Make sure to write out the scenario so that reviewers can understand what the prayers are for, since we are not as knowledgeable as God is.
