My pin for this Chivalric year is a copy of an 1850s Commandery pin from Philadelphia. This pin centers and emphasizes the Red Cross, meaning Christianity as the primary faith of the wearer, while recognizing the masonic love for followers of the same God (Jehovah). Manly speaking, it is a very York Rite-oriented pin, being that the Royal Arch and Cryptic Council are tied into the Old Testament, and the Commandery is primarily Christianity.
