Sir Knight Michael Thomas Huff was born on the sixth day of April, 1986, in Union, South Carolina, and was adopted at birth by Donald and Margaret Huff. Raised in Northern Virginia alongside his younger brother, Timothy, they established their home in McLean, Virginia, where he resides today. He holds a Bachelor of Arts and Sciences in Religion from George Mason University. His professional journey has encompassed the entertainment industry, the premium cigar sector, and project management. He presently serves as Marketing Coordinator for National Capital Treatment & Recovery, directing strategic communications and brand development in service to recovery and community wellness.

He was raised to the Sublime Degree of Master Mason in Henry Lodge No. 57 in Fairfax on January 24, 2012. He has twice presided as Worshipful Master, in 2016 and 2022, and likewise served as Worshipful Master of Alexandria-Washington Lodge No. 22. Within his district, he has led the local Ritual Schools and served as District Representative for York Rite Masonry. At the Grand Lodge level, he served as Associate Grand Chaplain and continues his labors as a member of the Committee on Public Relations.

Elected Grand Warder in 2022, he entered the advancing Grand Line with steadfast devotion to the future of Chivalric Masonry in Virginia.

Within Chivalric Masonry, Sir Knight Huff has served as Grand Commander's Aide-de-Camp and as Chairman of the Awards Committee. He is the recipient of the Charles A. Grice Award for Merit and was invested as a Knight Commander of the Temple by the Grand Encampment in 2022. He presently serves the Grand Encampment of Knights Templar of the United States of America as Chairman of the annual Easter Sunrise Observance.
